### Study area information for apprentices

#### Dress requirements / PPE

- Protective eye wear
  - No sunglasses are permitted in the workshop
  - Safety glasses must be clear and meet Australian Safety Standards
- Safety work boots must be worn at all times.
  - Heavy leather uppers and heavy-duty soles.
  - No sand shoe volley type of footwear allowed (even with steel caps)
- Hearing protection is required. This is a minimum requirement, as per safe operating procedures for using power tools. For hygiene reasons apprentice must provide their own.
- For outside work, students will be required to supply and wear a hat (wide brim type).
- No singlets are to be worn

#### Equipment / stationery

- A simple calculator capable of addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, percentage and square root.
- Lines scale (not needed for Rockingham students)
- Large 60o/30o set square and a 45o set square (approximately 200-300mm). (not needed for Rockingham students)
- 2H and 4H pencils
- Eraser
- Pens
- Leaver arch file to keep workbooks and handouts
- A4 lined paper for taking notes
- Blue or black pens
