### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

Applicants are required to be female,
Australian residents and must be competent in
communication and mathematics. These skills are
equivalent to completion of Year 10, but may also be
achieved through previous work or informal learning
experiences. The scholarship has been designed to
meet the needs of women who
are returning to work, seeking a career change, recently
completed high school or as an alternative pathway to
university. The learning environment
is structured to provide a high level of support for
students returning to formal education.


