- Provide a pathway to a career in engineering drafting, or as an engineering associate.

UEE21920 Certificate II in Electronics

Introduction to the world of electronics to gain knowledge and practical workshop skills.

MEM30522 Certificate III in Engineering – Technical

Learn general engineering concepts and how drawings are transformed into buildings and manufactured items.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants are required to be female or identify as female, Australian residents and must be competent in communication and mathematics. These skills are equivalent to completion of Year 10, but may also be achieved through previous work or informal learning experiences. The scholarship has been designed to meet the needs of women who are returning to work, seeking a career change, recently completed high school or as an alternative pathway to university. The learning environment is structured to provide a high level of support for students returning to formal education.

Interviews commence: 20 March

Scholarship begins: 15 April

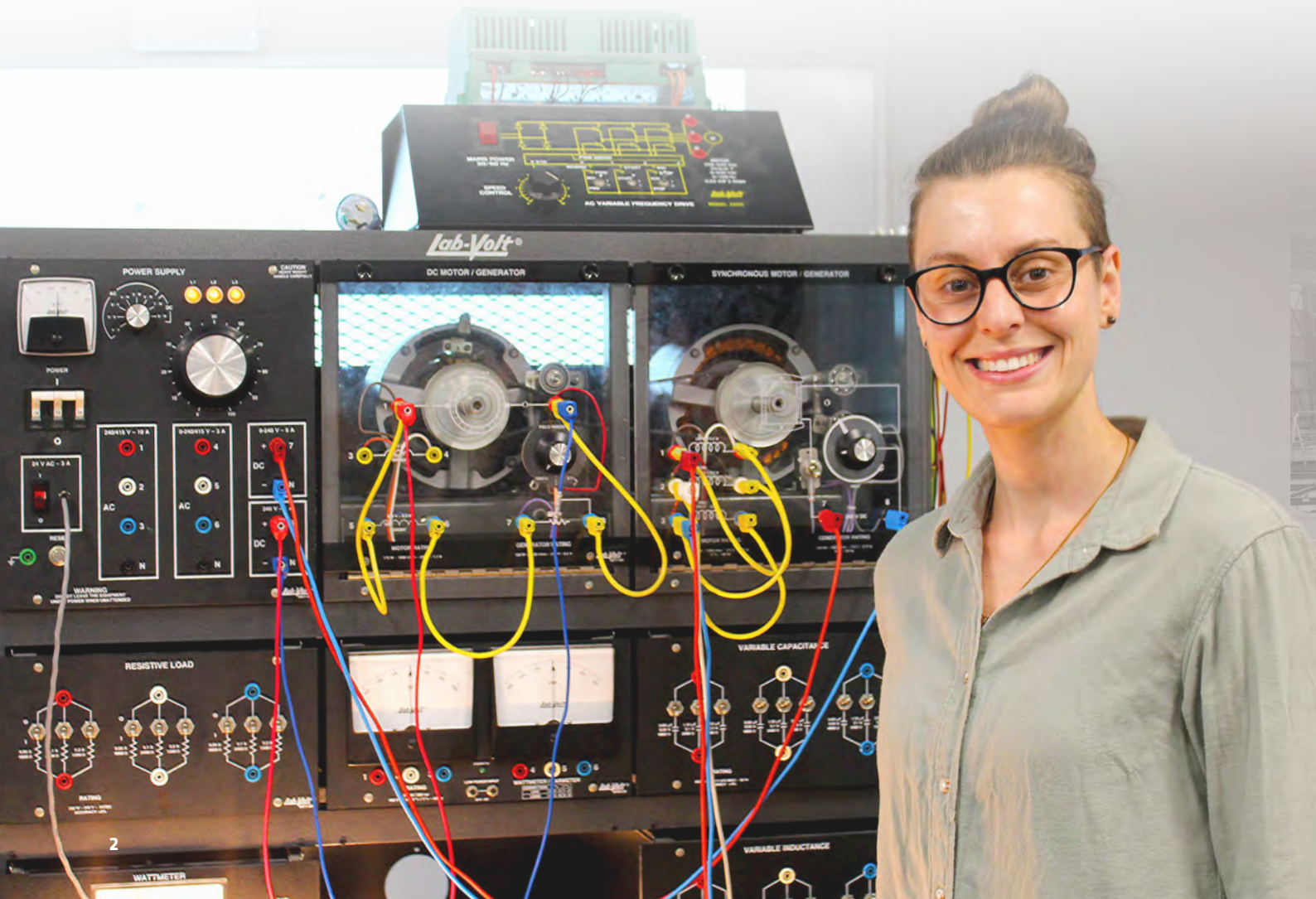
